## HOSTING TIPS

### WHEN CONSIDERING TECHNOLOGY

- ▶ Use what you have for viewing
  - ✓ Room with projector and screen?
  - ✓ TV monitor?
  - ✓ Computer screen?
- ▶ Consider speakers for larger rooms/spaces
- ▶ Make certain that WiFi capabilities are dependable and strong enough

Consider partnering with a neighboring church, library, or other venue if you do not have adequate equipment

### WHEN CONSIDERING LOCATION

- ▶ Select a room that is large enough for church congregants and community members
- ▶ Consider the number of pews, or tables and chairs needed
- ▶ Make certain that all attendees can view the screen/monitor
- ▶ Make certain all attendees know the location of bathrooms, exits, and drinking fountains

Consider partnering with a neighboring church, library, or other venue if you do not have adequate equipment

### WHEN CONSIDERING COMMUNITY

- ▶ Post conference flyers in the community and within your church
- ▶ Select a greeter to make visitors feel welcome
- ▶ Consider a local speaker to meet the specific needs of your church and community
- ▶ Consider hosting a local event that allows for church and community interaction
- ▶ Consider in community partners to encourage community attendance

Consider partnering with a neighboring church, library, or other venue if you do not have adequate equipment

### EXAMPLE LOCAL SPEAKER

- ▶ Nutritionist to share healthy snacks and meals for youth and potluck dinners
- ▶ Extension Agent to share health opportunities
- ▶ Physical Activity Specialist to share exercise recommendations for youth and families

### EXAMPLE LOCAL EVENT

- ▶ Host a healthy breakfast before conference, and/or lunch after the conference
- ▶ Work with your Extension Agent to host healthy lifestyle class or cooking demo
